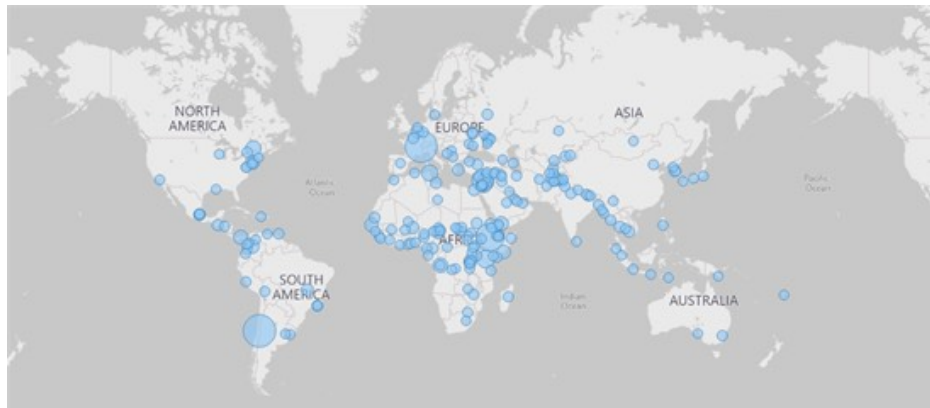

Courses for all levels from Complete Beginner to Intermediate to Advanced	<p>At Beginner to Intermediate Levels the focus is on communication skills and using Arabic in common everyday situations (e.g. ordering a meal, making plans for the weekend).</p> <p>At Advanced Level the focus is on reading comprehension, text analysis and grammar study.</p>	<p>All courses are carefully organised and structured to guide students along a clear learning path.</p> <p>Each unit is organised into modules that focus on different skills (language acquisition with listening and speaking activities, topic-related vocabulary work, reading and writing, grammar study, language practise and intercultural understanding). Each module is organised into a series of steps or tasks that contain detailed instructions, so learners know exactly what to do with each task.</p>	<p>Arabic Online treats Arabic as a dynamic living language.</p> <p>The courses combine language competence with cultural understanding together with a learner-centred, cognitive-constructivist approach (learning by doing).</p> <p>This barrier-free, task-based approach enables learners to communicate effectively at a level that suits their needs.</p> <p>The courses guide learners gradually towards a command of reading and writing, progressing from transliteration at level A1 to the introduction and use of Arabic script at levels A2 and beyond.</p> <p>Grammar study focuses on how to use the language and is presented in such a way that it can be understood by non-academic learners.</p>

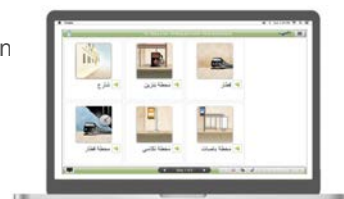

Chinese - YoYo Chinese

6 courses, including 3 conversational courses and 3 Chinese character courses, are offered with a total of ~1,000 lessons.

Course/Level	Skills	Structure	Methodology, Content and Goals
Conversational courses (Beginner, Intermediate, Upper Intermediate)	Chinese pronunciation, vocabulary, grammar, and conversational skills	Each course contains 6 levels (a total of 36 levels). Lessons consist of video lectures with clear explanations, real examples of spoken Chinese, and cultural insight.	The courses focus on using real Chinese dialogues as the core of the lesson content and expands upon those to teach additional vocab and grammar in clear and concise English that is easy to understand. The lessons build on previously learned content in earlier lessons for extra reinforcement. Each lesson contains flashcards, a recall/speaking activity, and a 10-question interactive quiz with various question types.
Character courses (Character I, Characters II, Character Reader)	Chinese character recognition, reading, and typing		The courses focus on teaching the most essential and high-frequency Chinese characters starting with the most frequent. The first two courses cover 600 Chinese characters and the Reader course has the student apply all 600 learned characters in an interactive story format. Like with conversational lessons, character lessons contain interactive practice and a 10-question quiz.

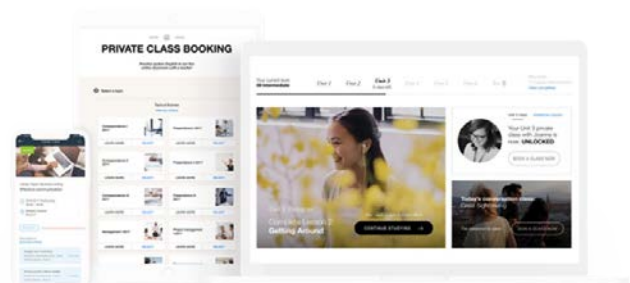

French - Institut Français

12 levels of online courses are distributed in units to provide learners with the ability to use French in real life situations.

Course/Level	Skills	Structure	Methodology, Content and Goals
Mon Cours En Ligne (MCEL)	5 language skills (oral and written comprehension, oral and written production, interaction)	The course has 12 levels, and each level has 6 units or modules that are organized as follows: description of objectives and tasks; oral and written comprehension, grammar, vocabulary, pronunciation, written and oral tasks; self-evaluation; and a final quiz.	<p>Communicative, based on tasks and interaction. Students learn how to use the language in real life situations to accomplish specific and meaningful tasks in different contexts. Grammar and vocabulary are first presented and taught through a variety of contextualized activities (written, audio, and visual), to respond to a specific objective, and covering one or more of the language skills.</p> <p>There is a forum for learner interactions. Topics include France and Francophonie, environment, social issues, literature, cinema, media... Tasks are based on cultural documents (audio, video, articles) and real interactions such as introducing yourself, describing a person, giving an opinion, etc. Some units cover professional themes such as work, health, sciences (depending on the level).</p>

The self-study online platform provides 16 courses distributed in 48 lessons.

A1 and A2 levels	Communication skills; grammar, vocabulary, reading and listening comprehension, writing, and speaking	Each level has two courses.	The lessons offer a wide range of interactive activities aimed to develop the student's communication skills. Many activities are based on real world attractive documents like videos, photos, illustrations, audios, articles, literature, etc. Some of the topics covered include introducing yourself and your family, talking environmental issues, science, professions, food, music, as well as topics related to the different Spanish speaking countries cultures and geography.
B1 to C1 levels		Each level has four courses.	The lessons are communicative, based on contextualized meaningful interactive activities and tasks to develop communication skills in a natural way. Like in real life, this type of activities requires the simultaneous activation of different communication skills like listening, speaking, interacting, etc.
