# Arabic – Arab Academy

Arab Academy provides a comprehensive learning experience with 24/7 access to the self-study online learning platform. 13 online courses of Modern Standard Arabic are offered starting from complete beginner at advanced (A1 to C2).

The program offers levels from complete beginner to advanced (A1 – C2)	This course is designed to assist students in acquiring the following skills: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Listening</li> <li>• Speaking</li> <li>• Reading</li> <li>• Writing</li> <li>• Cultural understanding</li> </ul>	Beginner levels: Each level is divided into lessons.  Intermediate and Advanced levels: Each level is divided into 4 – 5 study units. Each unit is further broken down into 4-5 lessons on different topics related to the unit's theme.	The teaching/learning process provided by Arab Academy courses follows a constructivist approach. It gives equal emphasis to the use of Arabic and communication in context by means of the four language skills: listening, speaking, reading and writing.  Participants learn to speak Arabic through lessons themed around real life situations. Learners are introduced to the nuances and unique attributes of Arab culture in order to understand the context of linguistic expression and exchanges. This helps to improve the effectiveness of their communication. The courses are also supplemented with facts and analogies to maximize development of language skills. # Chinese - YoYo Chinese

6 courses, including 3 conversational courses and 3 Chinese character courses, are offered with a total of ~1,000 lessons.

<b>Conversational courses</b> (Beginner, Intermediate, Upper Intermediate)	Chinese pronunciation, vocabulary, grammar, and conversational skills	Each course contains 6 levels (a total of 36 levels). Lessons consist of video lectures with clear explanations, real examples of spoken Chinese, and cultural insight. The first two courses cover 600 Chinese characters and the Reader course has the student apply all 600 learned characters in an interactive story format. Like with conversational lessons, character lessons contain interactive practice and a 10-question quiz.

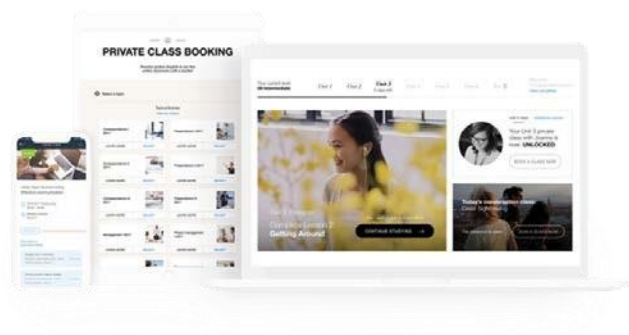

# French - Institut Français

12 levels of online courses are distributed in units to provide learners with the ability to use French in real life situations.

Mon Cours En Ligne (MCEL)	5 language skills (oral and written comprehension, oral and written production, interaction)	The course has 12 levels, and each level has 6 units or modules that are organized as follows: description of objectives and tasks; oral and written comprehension, grammar, vocabulary, pronunciation, written and oral tasks; self-evaluation; and a final quiz.	<p>Communicative, based on tasks and interaction. Students learn how to use the language in real life situations to accomplish specific and meaningful tasks in different contexts. Grammar and vocabulary are first presented and taught through a variety of contextualized activities (written, audio, and visual), to respond to a specific objective, and covering one or more of the language skills.</p> <p>There is a forum for learner interactions. Topics include France and Francophonie, environment, social issues, literature, cinema, media... Tasks are based on cultural documents (audio, video, articles) and real interactions such as introducing yourself, describing a person, giving an opinion, etc. Some units cover professional themes such as work, health, sciences (depending on the level).</p>
