2018 Summer Study Programme in China




Sponsored by the Chinese government, the UN Chinese Language Programme offers an annual three-week intensive summer study programme at Nanjing University in China. All students taking classes with the Chinese Language Programme and have completed at least Level 2 are eligible to apply. Tuition and housing are covered by the Chinese government. Staff members in the Secretariat can apply for Special Leave With Pay subject to the approval of their supervisors. The Programme dates for 2018 are Monday, 9 July to Friday, 27 July. 1. Log into INSPIRA <https://inspira.un.org>
2. Click **Main Menu** (below the UN logo) **Learning—Self-Service—My Learning**.



3. Now you can search the catalog by typing in the box *the first 4 digits of the course LMS Code* (available in the course schedule), or *the course name* or *placement* (for placement tests), and then click **Search**.

4. Click **Enroll** on the right of the course (or placement test) you want.
