

# Registration open for Language Placement Tests

Are you interested in taking – or again taking - a language course at the United Nations – in any of the six official UN languages, starting in January or February 2018?

If so, register now to take a Placement Test if:

- You are eligible to take United Nations language courses. All full-time United Nations staff are eligible and courses are free-of-charge.
- You are a new or returning student in our programme after a "two-term" break.
- You are <u>not</u> a beginner nor have very high proficiency in the language. If you are a beginner, you can register for Level 1 from 21 November 2017. If you are a high-level user of the language, contact <u>learning@un.org</u> to ask if you can take a high-level communication skills course without taking this test.

## Where is the United Nations Learning Centre?

\*The UN Learning Centre is situated in the former print shop underneath the UN's North Lawn. There are three ways to reach it (see attached floor map):

- From the 1st floor of the GA Building: take the elevators by the UN Meditation Room, go to 3B and follow the blue signs to the Learning Centre.
- From the elevators in the Conference Building: go to 2B and follow the blue signs.
- From the 1st floor of the Secretariat Building: take the stairs near the lobby café (stairway F) to 2B and follow the blue signs.
