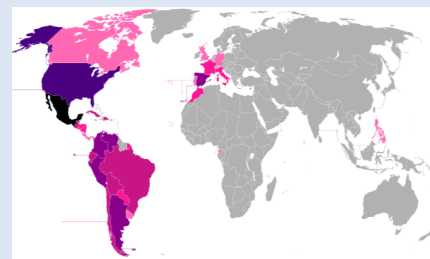
Specialized Courses
